*One Bryn Mawr unit is equivalent to four undergraduate semester hours or five graduate semester hours.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Close analysis of verbs of motion, verbal aspect, word order, and lexical groups. Emphasis is placed on the verbal activation of all material. Course also provides an introduction to Russian linguistics. Topics of study include nominal morphological categories, word formation, syntactical structures, and stylistics. The course also includes reading texts from a variety of mass media, with the aim of seeing practical applications of grammatical constructs. Students are expected to participate actively in class discussions, dialogues, and debates, as well as to prepare oral presentations and write short compositions. Regular written guizzes and one written final.

NUMBER OF HOURS: 70

Students are placed in small groups for class, based on proficiency level. Textbooks and course materials will be based according to group.

GRADING AND ASSESSMENT:

Class attendance is a critical part of progress in language and students are expected to come on time and prepared for each class.
